## ADVISORY

1. All doctors are required to familiar themselves with quality and hospital infection control practices.
2. All doctors are required to update themselves with latest Government issued COVID-19 Guidelines.
3. All doctors are directed to ensure and monitor that cleaning and disinfection protocols are strictly followed in their respected work area.
4. Sensitize and trained your department nursing staff, paramedical and house keeping staff in the area related to hospital infection protocols, COVID-19 management and quality protocols.
5. Documentation in IPD Files should be as per hospital norms, incomplete files will not be accepted in MRD.
6. Early discharge of stable patients should be ensured to prioritize the health care services for emergency care.
7. Ensure that Nursing Sister place their demand for store items in advance and indent their required medicines and consumables weekly.
8. All doctors are advise to prescribe one month medication to all chronic disease patients and call them for follow up after one month for routine checkup.
9. Medical Leave of any type has to be through a board of three doctors : 2 of concerned specialty and one RMO / Admin Doctor atleast one of SMO Rank.
10. Instruction for parking vehicle should be followed. No parking is allowed on and near the hospital ramp area outside Gynae OPD and main entrance, to allow ambulance for entry and exit.

# **SETUP PLAN FOR CORONA VIRUS PREPRADNESS**

## **AS ON 15-03-2020**

1. Duty Roster and Help Line Numbers to be displayed at 108 in emergency department for information of General Public.
2. IEC for Cough hygienic in the hospital premises.
3. Avoiding all unnecessary visits of susceptible population especially senior citizens and children.
4. Setting up and basic test counter for Cataract Surgery in OTs & OPDs.
5. To sensitize all patients to avoid unnecessary visits to the hospitals.
6. Not to call the patients frequently for consultation in chronic disorders. Prescriptions of chronic disease to be given for a longer period.
7. Directions to be issued from the main gate to the Corona isolation zone to avoid unnecessary movements in the hospital.
8. Human resource plan to be prepared for quarantine facility be withdrawing staff from Dispensaries / RBSK Team.
9. Plan to shift routine services out of the main hospital premises if required.
10. Postpone any unnecessary Workshops / Meetings / Conference / Gathering within the hospital premises.
11. Biomedical disposal should be proper and as per protocol. Specially to take care of used masks.
12. Chief Pharmacist to be ready with adequate stock, specially buffer stock.

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
